

In addition to this weekly ongoing program, plans are in progress to bring a virtual class on therapeutic yoga from no other than JSS sister institutions. As most of you know the JSS has more than 350 institutions, all dedicated to education, service to humanity, and spiritual development. One such institution is JSS Nature Cure and Yoga Hospital in Coimbatore, Tamil Nadu, India. Another one is in Mysuru. Both institutions have offered to extend their expertise to our benefit. # The new temple construction project has been progressing with the following developments:

- With the grace of HH Jagadguru Sri Shivarathri Deshikendra Mahaswamiji, the first sign of the construction is here by the removal of the barn. The barn demolition was completed in July.
- The Site Preparation contractor, Hamilton Site Preparation, began the work by removing the
  concrete flooring of the barn. Their work was temporarily halted to seek additional permission
  from the Montgomery County's Forest Conservation and Planning Department. The JSS SM and
  Construction Manager have been diligently working to expedite the county approval process.
- We are expecting the site preparation work to resume by the middle of August.
- The Construction Committee led by Umesh Murthy continues to hold biweekly meetings to review progress and disseminate information.
- One of the major challenges has been slow progress of the collection of donations and pledges. Of
  the total cost of \$15M, our initial goal is to raise \$7.5M to enable us to seek a bank loan for the
  remaining funds. We need to raise at least an additional \$4.3M for the bank to consider our
  application.
